My 22 year old daughter, Rebecca, passed away on 11/13/13 from malignant brain cancer & on the 13th of every month I drop off a batch of Jools' Chemo Buddies to the cancer center where she received monthly infusions. This is a project she and I developed before she died and I am continuing it in her honor. Jools' Chemo Buddies are clean, gently loved stuffed animals that are given to adult cancer patients. Rebecca believed that no one should have to go through chemo alone. This month's batch will be delivered on the 19th instead of the 13th in recognition of Batch of Kindness Day.

5 years ago, I graduated from university. What was one of the high points in my life was short-lived because my mother was diagnosed with breast cancer soon after. I foregone graduate school and moved back home to care for my mother while she underwent chemotherapy. She's been in remission for 2 years now. Since then, I've always intended on going back to volunteer my free time at the hospital my mother was treated. Time is a luxury I'm currently short of due to my work and grad school program. The #BatchofKindness campaign was the catalyst I needed. Every weekend of July I'm volunteering in the children's ward of the hospital. It's incredibly rewarding to be a source of support to these parents and families whose children are ill. Also, it's fun to give these children fun experiences while they're confined to the hospital. Playing games, reading books and just having a conversation with them has given me so much. I hope I've helped them as much as they've helped me.

I would like my first batch of kindness to be in the form of a thank you; first off to Michelle for all your hard work and enthusiasm and to all the Cumber Collective for giving me a place to be. My second act of kindness is going to happen at street level. I live in a large city and we have homeless and needy aplenty here. I personally have always been adverse to giving money to those begging alms on the street with a multitude of excuses like not wanted to have to take off my backpack and dig for my wallet, not wanting to be seen as a target on the street with my wallet out, and the worst excuse is simply turning a blind eye. This is going to change on July 19th! Of course the main reason it is going to change is because Benedict asked us to reach out. He's all of our role models in so many ways how can we deny his request. I will enjoy every last dollar I give with love and hope the small ripple effect created by all of us gives Ben a day that is awash in love and joy.

Since I was 9 or 10, I remember a Roma woman that used to work cleaning for several residents associations in our neighbourhood, until they decided to hire a proper employee from a cleaning service. She kept going from door to door, once a month or every two months asking for the charity of the neighbours: food, clothing, toys for her little children... At first she told us that she was looking for others associations to clean, she was confident about finding a new job because she had a lot of experience and several letters of recommendation.

But time went by and nobody employed her. She kept coming to our building and we were really happy to support her, but after all these years, old neighbours left and new ones arrived, not caring about her situation, and at the end only two or three of us kept helping her. Lucky for me, I'm currently working at my family business in the same street where I live, in a grocery store. We are always trying to give a helping hand to her and others that are in the same situation. It's really hard to see them struggling to get some food for the day. The good thing is that our shop works as a "center" of a web where clients left food/props/clothing for the people in need who come every day.

Two days ago this woman came to our store and didn't ask for food. She told us crying that she couldn't cook it, because her electric stove stopped working few days ago and she didn't want the food we usually give her to go off. Luckily, here was this man shopping and listening to her, and offered her an used but fully operational electric stove, to collect in our shop today, Saturday 19th at 11 am.

We'd had big smiles on our faces all morning. When she entered the shop and saw her new stove she had the most priceless face I've ever seen in my entire life. Tearful and almost speechless, she thanked us for all these years of support, telling us that their children think of us now with reason as a fairy god-mother.

Hi, Happy belated Birthday, Benedict!!! Wanted to post this on Saturday, but was sick and sitting in the ER at my local hospital (I'm fine!) Anyhow, this past week I donated some items to a local shop and felt good to give back, not just to people who REALLY need help, but also to our planet..... am waiting to hear about donating time at a local Habitat for Humanity because homelessness and loss of any kind, for an individual or a family, is something that we all share on some level throughout our lives, or we are touched by either in our society... I have an adorable Nana, who just turned 93 on the 14th, and she has always said that it is kindness towards others that has gotten her to this beautiful age, and she's as smart as a whip!!! She wants me to help her clean out some of her clothes, purses and such to donate to her church for their garage sale next month! I will gladly help her, not only do I get to spend time with her, but I'll donate some of my excess things as well, (and help her beloved church) These things seem small, but am so proud to help our planet and all of us who live here, plus get to spend time with my hero, Viola, er, Nana!!!!

I never truly volunteered though (apart from cultural events) and this website inspired me to make a first step. Today I contacted some institutions with whom I will be working soon - helping elderly and one other. Thank you for inspiration. Actually I had an amazing day and It seemed she was happy for a while. Today I visited her again cos we've made a "deal" I will shop for her when she needs. And also she asked me if I couldn't come often to help her clean the house. (it was really difficult to me to go and ask her, I am bad in talking to people because I often get nervous and can't speak so I actually helped myself too. I am glad I did it and glad that something like #batchofkindness helped me and gave me the opportunity to do a good thing)

I won't be able to do things all day on July 19th as I work, but I'll try to do some little things. However, I'll share with you the biggest thing I do and will always be doing. I have been a volunteer for my local humane society for five years. It started out walking dogs, but it turned into so much more. Before I knew it, I would be spending time with extremely ill animals before they run in paradise at the Rainbow Bridge, I would become a failed foster three times over, I would be receiving two or three hours of sleep because a fearful dog is too afraid to come into the house at night, I would be learning physical therapy on dogs while fostering an amputee after they were hit by a car, I would be out in the community speaking about what we do and debunking the myths of animal welfare, and I would be the one who fosters the most mentally or physically damaged dogs that need a second chance at life.

I live and breathe this way of life, and the best part? So does my husband. He supports this 1000%. Yes. One thousand percent. This way of life comes with much reward with little thanks, but that doesn't bother me. When I see an animal leave my home healthy and happy, I always think that's the way the animal is saying thank you to me. Sometimes, it comes with great sadness because the sixteen year old little Yorkshire Terrier couldn't hold on any longer or the tumors just won't stop growing on the six year old Great Dane. At that moment, you dedicate a full day to them doing fun dog things before they no longer need to suffer.

Regardless, it's rewarding either way. You either see a dog you fostered get adopted, you become a failed foster and adopt that animal, or you let that animal go to the Rainbow Bridge knowing you gave them a better life than what they have previously experienced.

This is what I do as a second full time job, and I wouldn't have it any other way.

Before I leave a message for Benedict, I would like to extend my most sincere gratitude and a deep heartfelt thank you to Michelle for this beautiful idea that has united Benedict admirers from all across the world! Thank you so much Michelle :-) Your efforts will most certainly be rewarded manifold in kind!

Benedict Cumberbatch has successfully managed to melt hearts across the planet with his suave personality and not to forget, his limitless generosity towards everyone. Come July 19 this year, I intend to perform one such act of random kindness by distributing school supplies to children at one of the government schools located in my area. We also have a local children's hospice which I have no connection with, other than their charity brooches were used as the favours for the female guests at my wedding 6 years ago (great idea by my Mum). The hospice receives no government subsidy or funding and took 10 years from the establishment of the charity to raise funds to build it, to finally opening its doors in 2008. Anyway they also run a lottery to raise funds, so I decided to resume doing this as my bit of 'batch of kindness'. I tweeted that this is what I was doing, and both hospices favoured my tweets!

Over the weekend I had a brainwave, having seen pictures of a Facebook friend's son with his 'best friends' the Meerkats - if you're not in the UK, these CGI Russian-accented creatures (they are brilliant, You Tube is your friend) are used to advertise a comparison website for anything from insurance to energy suppliers, and when you sign up successfully or accept your quote, you can select a toy. This little boy is autistic and already has 3 of them, I had one sitting on a shelf in its box doing nothing (and I'm 42, do I really need one?) so I contacted his Mum on FB last night and asked if he would like another one to add to his collection. Again, not a huge thing but it makes me happy. A Benedict-related side-note, the actor who voices the main Meerkat character also appeared in an episode of Cabin Pressure.

For me, this is an ongoing thing and rather unrelated, but just wanted to let Benny know that many of his fans dedicate themselves to a life of serving others. I've been volunteering with a Therapeutic Horsemanship program to help people with special needs for 7 or so years, and now am actively working to become a Certified Instructor through PATH Intl. I'm currently getting my student teaching hours in, and will be going back to teach three hours tonight using my own lesson plan. (Taught last night under someone else). When I become certified, it will honestly be one of the proudest moments of my life :) I also have hope to become an Equine vet, and will be able to help/serve others that way as well.

Just yesterday an incredible thing happened- one of the riders who is nonverbal and often acts out physically took one of the instructor's heads in between her hands and gently as a lamb touched her lips to the instructor's forehead. The rider walked away smiling, and we were left literally standing in awe. That, Ben, is my birthday gift to you- dedicating my life to helping others.

I saw a pattern in a knitting catalogue for an amazing moebius scarf, along with the most beautiful cashmere yarn that would complement perfectly your whatever-the-hell-color-that-is eyes.
